

### **PAGE 8: SCIENCE**

- ⇒ Lakshadweep Marine Museum, located in the capital city of Kavaratti, is a fascinating treasure trove of marine life and ecological wonders. It offers a captivating journey into the Arabian Sea's underwater realm and allows visitors to explore and appreciate its rich marine biodiversity. The waters around the islands are home to over 600 species of marine fishes, 78 species of corals, 82 species of seaweeds, 52 species of crabs, 2 species of lobsters, etc.
- ⇒ Samudrika Naval Marine Museum is a Port Blair based tourist attraction located in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, also known as Fisheries Museum. The Indian Navy runs the museum and it stores as many as five galleries representing history, geography, anthropology and marine life of the islands. There is also a small zoo that is home to saltwater crocodiles in Haddo of the Andaman Islands. There are a number

of informative installations on the island's ecosystem, plants, animals, tribal communities, marine life, etc.

It does not matter anymore if the dealer takes the entire summer

mending my compressor. And as I nursed my warm *sherbet* in the heat of the day, I thanked my stars that I could drink clean water whenever I felt thirsty.
