MY CONTRIBUTION TO THE ENVIRONMENT


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- I promise not to waste water this Summer.




TRACE AND COLOUR

- Playing with play dough






CATERPILLAR (LONG/ SHORT)




INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Take 2 socks of different colours.
- 2. Stuff the socks with polyester stuffing, cotton balls or scraps of yarn.
- 3. Tie rubber bands around the socks to create segments. You can also use pieces of colourful yarn for a long caterpillar to make 8 segments and for a short caterpillar make 6 segments.
- 4. Paste googly eyes and a smiley face.
- 5. Long and short caterpillars are ready to race.



- 4. Provide them glitter, and sequins in different colours and encourage them to decorate the pictures.
- 5. Label the sheet.

- 6. Kindly label and laminate it.




STORY TIME

We teach our children to learn to value books and stories which spark the child's imagination and stimulate curiosity. It helps to develop the child's concentration, social and communication skills.


- 1. Help your child to read a short story.

- Cucumber sandwich.




SNAIL CRAFT

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Buttons
- CD/ Cardboard
- Pastel Paper
- Glue
- Googly Eyes
- Colourful Pens

INSTRUCTIONS:

- To start you are going to cut out a shape for your snail out of pastel paper. Make sure to make it big enough to leave some room so that you can glue it to your CD.
- 2. If you don't have an old CD to reuse for this craft you can use a piece of cardboard, just cut it into a circle big enough for the snail shell.
- **3.** Cover the CD in glue and decorate it with colourful buttons. Paste googly eyes and draw smiley face on it.





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Keep it fun and engaging! Let your child take the lead and be creative.

- Use simple instructions and break down activities into smaller steps.
- Encourage them to explore, experiment and make mistakes. That's all part of the learning process.
