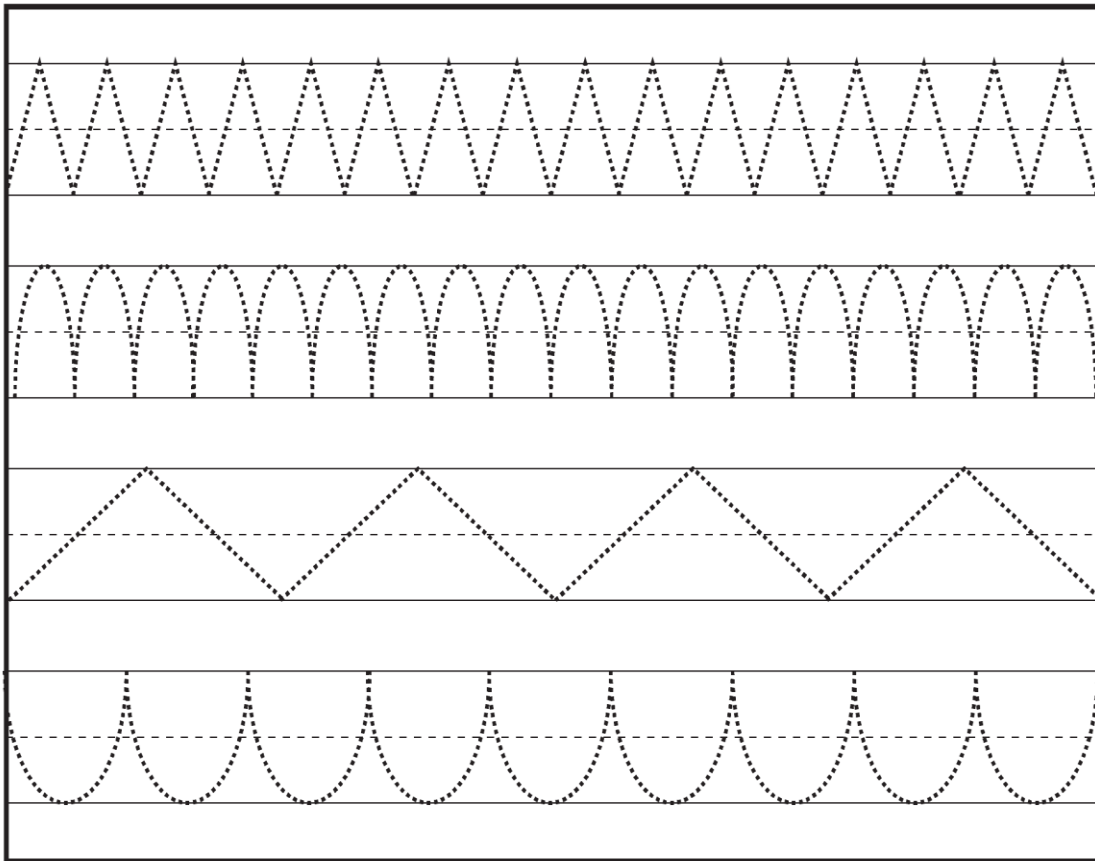


**Dear Parents**

Holidays are great, but schoolwork can be fun filled and inspiring too! As the school closes for the summer break we have planned some activities/ worksheets for your child to enhance his/her learning skills in a fun-filled way.

**ENGLISH:**

Practice the following patterns



- Learn any one Alphabet Rhyme.
- Buy/Borrow different story books, picture books and colouring books.
- Do picture reading.
  - Recall the characters and incidents of the story.
  - Colour the sheets in the colouring books.
  - Narrate bed time stories to your child.

**MATH:**

- Paste pictures corresponding to the numbers 1-10  
(Use a separate page for each number)
- Learn Oral counting 1-10

**GENERAL KNOWLEDGE:**

- Nature walk: Go for a nature walk early in the morning with your child. On your way, talk about the trees, birds etc.
- Remember to share your fun moments with us - get pictures clicked of yourself and family. Paste them in a scrapbook which everyone can admire.
- Paste five pictures each of objects that are of the following colours: Red, Yellow, Blue, Green, Black

### ENGLISH CONVERSATION:

It is also important that your child learns to converse in English. Here are some tips.....

- The child should say his/her name in a full sentence.
- Teach the child to use short sentences e.g.
  - May I go to the wash room?
  - Please open my water bottle/Tiffin box.
  - May I drink water?
- Drill phonic sounds with your child. (Refer to the chart attached)
- Do picture reading with your child.

### VALUE EDUCATION:

- Give Responsibilities: Even little ones can be taught to help in daily chores. They can help in laying the table, filling the water bottles, dusting, cleaning their cupboard, arranging their toys etc.

**WORKSHEET I: TRACE THE PATTERNS**

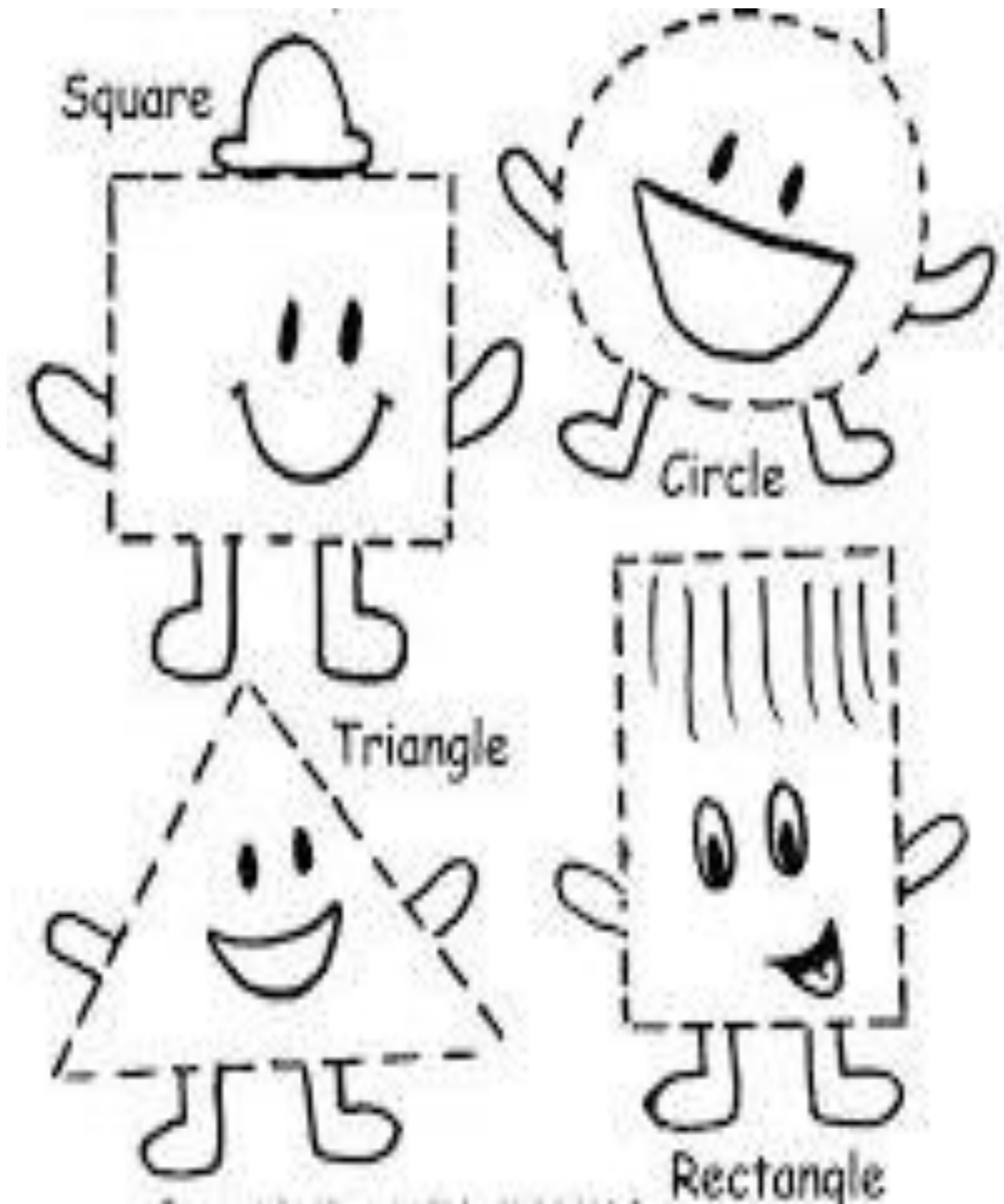
  **TRACING LINES**

- 7. A wavy line ending in a heart.

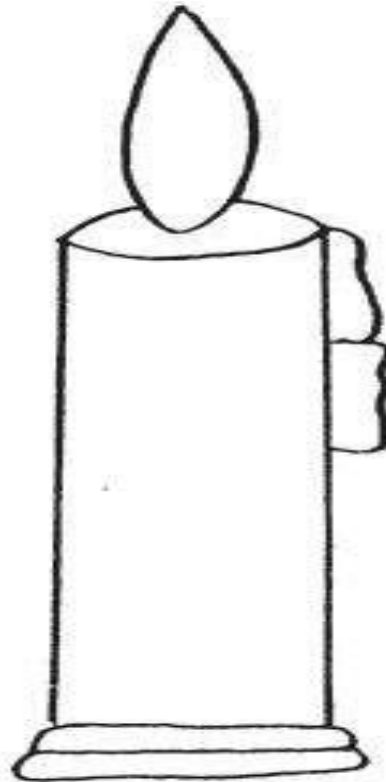
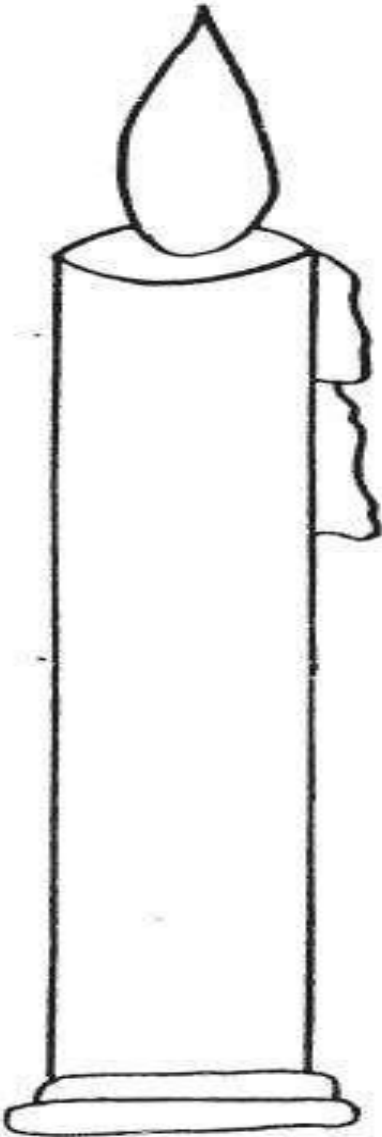
**WORKSHEET 2: COLOURS & SHAPES**
